We warmly welcome families and young children to all services at our three Parish churches.

At St Helen's and St Thomas on the first Sunday of every month we hold a short service of Open Worship with hymns, stories, prayer and activities. At every other Sunday service at St Helen's we run 'Light Keepers': separate child centred activities. Children are welcome to take part or remain in church (*although we do ask that if very small children participate, a parent/carer remains with them*). Light Keepers return in time for us to share communion and blessing together

We also run Messy Church on most second Sundays of the month. This is an afternoon of games, crafts and cooking held in the Done Room for families.
