Tarporley Bellingers Striking Success

On a lovely May Day (Saturday the 12th) Tarporley bellringers went to St Mary's Church Dodleston to meet with other bellringing teams from around Chester and compete in a 'Striking Competition'.

Despite its name this is neither a combat sport nor a test of how fast one can withdraw one's labour. It is simply a social gathering combined with a test of how well each team can ring the bells to produce melodic ringing with the notes (strikes) evenly spaced.

There were eight teams (Tarporley entered two) and the Judge (Greg Morris from North Wales) declared that one of our two teams had the least number of blemishes and pronounced us as WINNERS!

Memorial Walk

As part of Tarporley Remembers 2018 a Memorial Walk has been made through the area of land that runs between St Helen's and the Done Room drive.
