In this WW1 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary year, St Thomas' and St John's are commemorating the part played by the soldiers who lost their lives in the conflict with displays of the relevant "There but not There" silhouettes from the 'Tarporley Remembers' Exhibition in St Helen's Church. Everyone is invited to see them from now until 1<sup>st</sup> November, at our Sunday Services, or by arrangement at other times.

Then on **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November** all of the soldiers will return to St Helen's for a special afternoon which will include refreshments, poetry, music and dramatic readings.
