Tarporley 'Cards for Good Causes'

The shop which sells Christmas Cards for more than 30 national charities will be open as usual in the Baptist Chapel this year.

The Tarporley shop is part of the 'Cards for Good Causes' national network of over 300 shops which in the past 5 years have raised over £20 million out of which charities have to pay for the production and distribution of their Christmas cards and any VAT. At least 70 pence in every £1 goes to the charities.
